# Eglin AFA Annual Education Recognition Event

On 17 May 2012, Eglin AFA hosted its annual Education Recognition Event at the Air Armament Museum. This event honors our local scholarship winners and our teacher of the year. We take funds that we raise in the annual Doolittle Scholarship Open Golf Tournament (see the article on page 2 about the 2012 DSO) and in turn provide scholarships to local Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps (JROTC) cadets and students from the local CHOICE Aviation Institutes at Choctaw and Crestview High Schools.

The Chapter's Education Foundation is now in its 40th year, and has provided over \$1 million in scholarships to extremely worthy students. The Foundation has recently expanded its efforts by providing assistance to the CHOICE Aviation Institute as it starts programs at both Pryor and Shoal River Middle Schools. It also provides support with trophies for the various math and science competitions in the county.

This year Eglin AFA presented \$22,000 in scholarships to 9 students as well as recognizing the Eglin AFA Teacher of the Year. The students self-nominate through their JROTC and CHOICE Aviation Institute programs and instructors. In turn, the Eglin AFA Chapter has to evaluate and rank the scholarship applications. Every student who applies is always at the top of their peer group and making the decisions is incredibly challenging.

In addition, Eglin AFA recognized our Teacher of the Year, Mr. Stephen Moczary from CHOICE Aviation Institute Crestview High School. This award is given, in the spirit of Christa McAuliffe for demonstrated excellence in education and in recognition of sustained & outstanding performance as an educator and unequalled dedication to ensuring that America's students are prepared for future aerospace technology challenges. Mr. Moczary is the Aeronautical Science for Management Instructor at the CHOICE Aviation Institutes at Crestview and Choctaw High Schools. He teaches several versions of a flying safety-related module on human factors/vestibular illusions. He also taught a version of this class to the Hurlburt AFA Chapter's Annual Teacher Workshop in January. He is the Human Factors/Flying Safety expert on staff.

We were delighted to have District Representative Helen Rigdon from Congressman Jeff Miller's office attend. Congressman Miller sent a letter to each scholarship recipient congratulating them and further recognized Mr. Moczary by reading a citation in the House of Representatives about Mr. Moczary's fantastic accomplishments.
